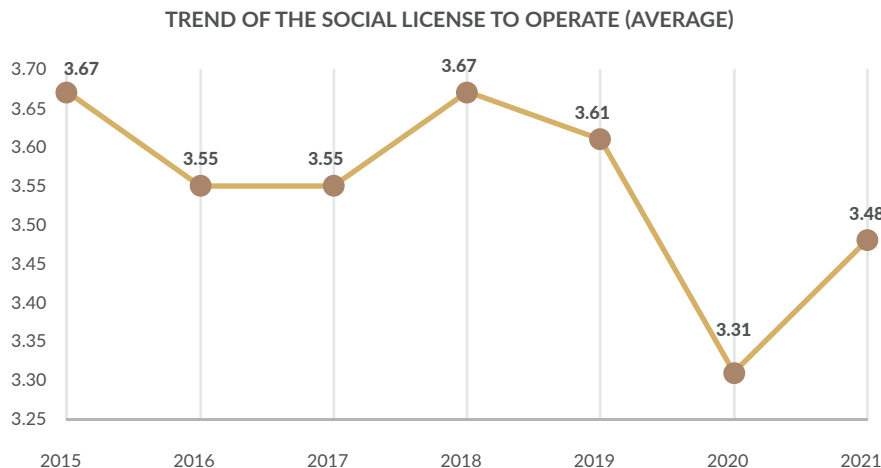
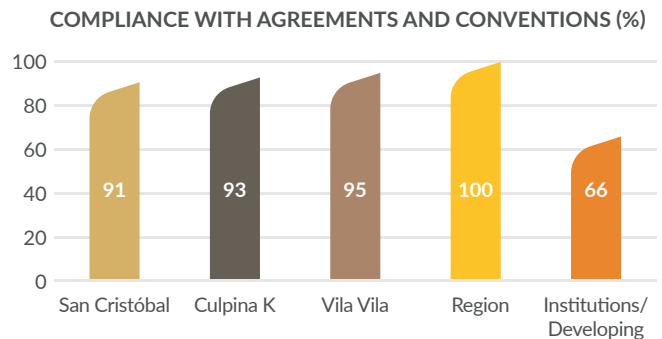
Community investment

The community investments mainly focused on basic services 65%, followed by investments in infrastructure improvements 8% and investments in technical assistance, health and community relations 6%.



Compliance of agreements and covenants with communities

Within the framework of our management policy and our corporate values, we have a solid track record of complying with agreements with the communities, local and regional organizations. Thus, overall progress in this compliance reached 89% in 2021:



Social License to Operate (SLO)

This year, the average score was 3.48, meaning that the level of "tolerance" with our stakeholders was maintained. Compared to the average SLO score of the previous year (3.31), there was an increase, mainly thanks to the reactivation of direct relations with our stakeholders at the local and regional level.
