1. Introduction

- Emergency preparedness and response plans and communication with nearby communities,
- Regular internal and external audits.

- Aligning our policies, procedures, and management systems with the specific requirements of the GISTM,
- Appointing technical personnel with proven competency in tailings management,

- Keeping up-to-date records of risk assessments, inspections, and maintenance,
- Publicly disclosing our progress in implementing the GISTM.
